HOLY ANGELS TIME & TALENT INTENTION FORM

The following opportunities are currently available for your involvement and your witness. It is the goal of our Church to have every family involved in at least one area of witness and service through our parish community. *This is the essence of being a Stewardship Parish.*

1. **ADULT CHOIR:** Men, women and those of high school age who sing at the 11:00 a.m. Mass beginning the Sunday after Labor Day until the Feast of Corpus Christi.
 2. **ALTAR SERVERS:** Boys and girls in the fourth grade or above who assist in the celebration of Mass and other liturgies.
 3. **ALTAR SOCIETY:** A group which prepares the altar and sanctuary for Sunday Mass. They clean the altar area, the vessels and linens and mark the Mass book to the day's readings.
 4. **CANTOR:** A person who sings the Psalm following the First Reading and directs the parishioners in singing the music of the Mass.
 5. **CHORISTERS / INSTRUMENTALISTS:** Boys and girls in grades 3 through 10 who sing or play an instrument. The Chorister season runs from the Sunday after Labor Day until the Feast of Corpus Christi.
 6. **C.C.D. TEACHER:** A Catechist (C.C.D. teacher) in our religious education program. Our faith is shared with children in grades Kindergarten through 10.
 7. **EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION:** Ministers who distribute Holy Communion at Mass and to homebound parishioners. They also visit the Curtis Home and Baptist Home on a rotating schedule.
 8. **FUNERAL CHOIR:** Adult volunteers who sing at a funeral Mass.
 9. **GREETERS:** Men and women who welcome parishioners as they arrive for Mass, coordinate the offertory and special collections, and ensure the comfort of the parish family.
 10. **LECTORS:** Men and women who proclaim the Word of God at all weekend Masses and other liturgies.
 11. **LEGION OF MARY:** A group of men and women who visit the hospitalized, the shut-ins and families of the newly baptized. They meet weekly for devotion and recitation of the Rosary.
 12. **RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (R.C.I.A.):** A process designed to familiarize inquirers with our Catholic Faith. Men or women are needed to present 1 or 2 sessions to the candidates.
- ◆ **OTHER PARISH MINISTRIES:**
- ◆ **Community Action Committee:** This committee coordinates projects to benefit parishioners in need. Activities may include bottle drives, coordinating food baskets for the poor, and various collections of useful items.
 - ◆ **Pro-Life Outreach Ministry Committee:** A committee of men and women who inform the parish of the Pro-Life movement in the city, state and nation, emphasizing the sacredness of life from conception to natural death.
 - ◆ **Scholarship Committee:** People who meet to select the recipient(s) of the Reverend Alfred R. Merusi Memorial Scholarship.
 - ◆ **Social Committee:** Volunteers who plan the Parish's social events providing a sense of parish family.
 - ◆ **Volunteers:** People who help the Parish and CCD office with mailings, answering the phone, filing, and grounds keeping. Students may be eligible for Community Service hours.
 - ◆ **Young-at-Heart:** A social group for men and women of 55 years and older who gather for Mass, meeting and luncheon the first Friday of each month from September to June. Volunteers are needed to help serve the luncheon.
 - ◆ **Youth Group:** Students in grades 6-12 who meet for various activities within our parish, or with other Catholic churches in our area.
